Warm Drinks

- Ensure your soft drinks cooler has power to the unit. Typically, the coolers will have a power light and you should be able to hear them running.
- 2) Check that the soda pump switch (if fitted) is in the on position. If this had been switched off, turn it back on, return to the bar and pull through the carbonated water on your dispenser until the water comes back through cold.
- 3) Check that all grills and vents are clear from obstructions and that they are not blocked up. To clean use a firm brush (never use your hands) and then allow about an hour for the cooler to build an ice bank.
- 4) On the top right side of the cooler, there will usually be an inspection cap, remove this to check if there is an ice bank in the unit. If the unit is not making ice or the issues persist after following the above steps, contact your service provider.






